- ▶ JAE Booklet
- ▶ GCE O Level Certificate

# Registration Process

- ▶ Before accessing JAE-IS, must complete the Course Application Worksheet, provided in Form A or in JAE information booklet
- ▶ Make full use of the 12 choices
- ▶ Will require NRIC or FIN, JAE-Pin (from Form A)
- ▶ Sing Pass is NOT required
- ▶ Takes approximately 15 minutes

- ▶ Would see a copy of the Verification Slip (VS) online after clicking on <submit> button
- ▶ Print Verification Slip and retain a copy of it as proof of course application

# Posting Results

- ▶ Scheduled for release on Thursday 1 Feb 2018 through
  - JAE-IS (accessible through JAE website)
  - SMS to mobile phone number provided by applicant during registration

# Direct School admission-Junior College (DSA-JC) Exercise

- ▶ Students who had accepted offers through the 2017 DSA-JC Exercise will be admitted to their chosen JC if they have met the eligibility criteria for admission based on their GCE O-Level examination results.
- ▶ Students admitted to a JC through DSA-JC will not be eligible to participate in the JAE.
- ▶ Students who do not meet the JC admission criteria may take part in JAE to apply for courses they are eligible for.

# Early Admission Exercise (EAE)

- ▶ Students who had accepted conditional offers to a polytechnic course through EAE in 2017 and have their offers confirmed based on their GCE O-Level examination results will not be eligible to participate in JAE.
- ▶ Their EAE offers are confirmed if they meet the following criteria:
  - ▶ a. A net ELR2B2 score of 26 points or better for the GCE O-Level examinations; and
  - ▶ b. Minimum Entry Requirements for the respective polytechnic course.
- ▶ Students who do not meet the above criteria may take part in JAE.

# JAE Posting

15

- ▶ To consider your course choices wisely. Posting is based on merit according to your net aggregate scores (taking into account the various bonus points eligible)
- ▶ Make use of your 12 choices. Advisable to indicate at least 2-3 courses where your aggregate scores are much better than the previous year's course cut-off points (COP)
- ▶ Appeals for transfer to another JC are not likely to be successful unless you meet the COP of the JC course for that year's JAE

# Application to Repeat Sec 4E or 5NA

## Retention Criteria

- ▶ obtained not more than 2 GCE 'O' Level passes (excluding CCA) and an aggregate of 44 points or less in 5 subjects (excluding CCA).

OR

- ▶ obtained 3 or more GCE 'O' Level passes (excluding CCA) but do not qualify for admission to JCs, MI or Polytechnics (ELR2B2 aggregate of 27 points or more after accounting for CCA bonus points)

# Application to Repeat Sec 4E or 5NA

## Retention Criteria

- ▶ Has enrolled in a Govt or Govt-aided school in 2017.
- ▶ Attempted the GCE 'O' Level Examination for the first time in 2017.
- ▶ S'pore Citizens / PR – will not be more than 4 yrs overage (i.e. born on or after 2 Jan 1997 for Sec 5NA, and born on or after 2 Jan 1998 for Sec 4E).
- ▶ International Students – will not be more than 2 yrs (i.e. born on or after 2 Jan 1999 for Sec 5NA, and born on or after 2 Jan 2000 for Sec 4E).
