

CHOIR & AVA HK LEARNING JOURNEY 2013



In line with the school's aims of ensuring our students develop a holistic and well-rounded aesthetic education,

the 5D4N Choir and AVA Educational Learning Journey saw 32 students and 4 teachers experience an exchange of cultural and aesthetic knowledge.

Reaching in the evening on our first day, our students headed for a sumptuous dinner and checked into Panaroma hotel, where they spent an hour rehearsing for the next day's activities.

The next two days saw us having school exchanges with the local schools. For the first school exchange, we were warmly welcomed by the PAOC Ka Chi Secondary School's Vice Principal and student volunteers, who brought us around the school, introducing their school's culture and vision. Being highly focused on ICT, students and teachers alike caught a glimpse of the many affordances of ICT that the school had, like their Creative Media Centre which enabled them to broadcast their school's assembly live twice a week. As part of our cultural exchange, our students performed a medley of their performance songs to showcase our own Singapore flavour. Our students also had the time to sit into an English class, where they made new friends and shared life experiences.





The second school we visited was the Elegentia College. Having a strong emphasis on inculcating students with a strong aesthetic foundation, the Elegentia College was an eye-opener for students and teachers alike as we toured the school's facilities and saw the students' aspirations to soar beyond the ordinary. Our students also had the opportunity to perform for the entire Form 1 and Form 2 levels, which boosted their confidence and stage exposure.

Apart from school exchanges, the choir students also had the opportunity to have public performances at a shopping mall and the notable Disneyland. Performing a medley of carols, the choir students were able to stand on a global stage to showcase their talents. This helped them to increase their confidence and stage know-how.

Our students also had the chance to visit famous attractions in Hong Kong. With our knowledgeable guide, our students toured famous Hong Kong landmarks like Repulse Bay, Victoria Peak, Avenue of Stars, Tai O Village and the National History Museum.
